2007 U.S. Taekwondo Association Championships Rules & Regulations

Code of Conduct: All instructors, students, and parents must act in a courteous and respectful manner at said event. There will be an arbitration committee to handle any complaints that may arise from refereeing.

Form Rules & Regulations: Students must demonstrate a recognized martial art form. In the event of a tie, students must do another form. Beginner students who only know one form will be allowed to do that form again.

Weapons Rules & Regulations: Center referee has the discretion to check any and all weapons being demonstrated in competition. In the event of a tie, students may demonstrate the same form and a show of hands will break the tie.

Breaking Rules & Regulations: All breaking materials must be purchased at the tournament. There will be a maximum of 4 stations allowed for each student. The degree of difficulty will be in this order (from most difficult to least): jump spinning kick break, spinning kick break, jumping kick break, standing kick break, hand technique break, elbow smash break. In the event of a tie, students will demonstrate the technique again and a show of hands will determine the winner.

Fighting Rules & Regulations: The rules will be modified USAT Olympic sparring rules. The duration of the rounds for age 12 & under will be 2 – 1 minute rounds with a 30 second rest, age 13-17 will be 2 – 90 second rounds with a 30 second rest, age 18 – 34 will be 2 – 2 minute rounds with a 30 second rest, age 35 & over will be 2 – 1 minute rounds with 30 second rest.

Competition breakdown

There will be no more than 8 students in a form, weapons, or breaking divisions. There will be no more than 4 students in a fighting division. Boys/Girls, Men/Women will compete together in forms, weapons, and breaking. They will not compete together in fighting, except in the Little Dragons division.
